

Space Ranger Simple Panel Quilt

Finished Quilt size: approx. 60" x 78"

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurements on borders are approximate; measure your quilt top before cutting border fabrics.

Fabric Requirements

Fabric A: Space Panel 2700-600	1 yard (1 panel)
Fabric B: Black/blue Planets 2700-300	1/2 yard
Fabric C: Grey Craters 2700-100	1/4 yard
Fabric D: Light Blue Spaceships 2700-407	5/8 yard
Fabric E: Red Stars 2700-208	1/2 yard
Fabric F: Medium Blue Stars 2700-217	5/8 yard
Fabric G: Stripe 2700-500	1 3/4 yards
Fabric H: Navy Stars 2700-227 (binding)	5/8 yard
Backing: Your choice	3 1/2 yards

Cutting

Cut the panel to measure 35 1/2" x 44 1/4".
Cut two 2 1/2" x 44 1/4" strips, and two 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" strips.*
Cut two 1 1/2" x 48 1/4" strips and two 1 1/2" x 41 1/4" strips.*
Cut two 4 1/4" x 50 1/4" strips and two 4 1/4" x 49" strips.*
Cut two 2 1/2" x 58 1/4" strips.*
Cut two 3 1/2" x 58 1/4" strips.*
Cut two 9" x 58 1/4" matching strips from the stripe.
Cut eight 2 1/2" x WOF strips and piece for binding.
Cut and sew into one 60" x 78" piece for backing.

**Cut WOF strips and piece to create correct size.*

Assembly Instructions

1. Sew the 2 1/2" x 44 1/4" Fabric B strips to the top and bottom of the panel.
2. Sew the 2 1/2" x 39 1/2" Fabric B strips to the sides of the panel.
3. Sew the 1 1/2" x 48 1/4" Fabric C strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
4. Sew the 1 1/2" x 41 1/4" Fabric C strips to the sides of the quilt top.
5. Sew the 4 1/4" x 50 1/4" Fabric D strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
6. Sew the 4 1/4" x 49" Fabric D strips to the sides of the quilt top.
7. Sew the 2 1/2" x 58 1/4" Fabric E strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
8. Sew the 3 1/2" x 58 1/4" Fabric F strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
9. Sew the 9" x 58 1/4" Fabric G strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
10. Layer, quilt and bind the quilt as desired.
