Window Boxes I & II

Please read all instructions carefully before starting. All instructions include a 1/4" seam allowance and strips are cut from selvage to selvage unless otherwise stated.

Instructions for Window Boxes I

Approximate size 76" x 100"

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - **cut 4 - 7 1/2" x 12 1/2" and 4 - 7 1/2" x 7 1/2"
(center designs evenly)

Fabric B - cut 4 identical border stripes 7" x approximately 108" (LOF) to be mitered

Fabric C - cut 3 - 12 1/2" strips, subcut 9 - 12 1/2" squares

Fabric E - cut 3 - 4 1/2" strips

Fabric F - **cut 8 - 3" strips, subcut 8 - 3" x 7 1/2" and 16 - 3" x 12 1/2"

Fabric I - inner border - cut 9 - 2 1/2" strips

BINDING - cut 9 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

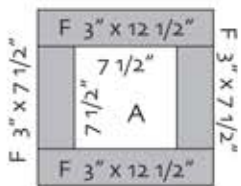
Fabric J - cut 9 - 2 1/2" strips (4 patches)

cut 9 - 4 1/2" strips, from 4 1/2" strips subcut 36 - 4 1/2" squares (the remaining 4 1/2" strips will be sewn with **E** for the middle row)

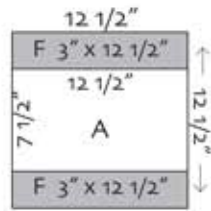
Fabric K - cut 9 - 2 1/2" strips (4-patches)

2. Piecing Order:

1. Make 8 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.) blocks by sewing **F** borders around **A** panel blocks. Sew **SIDE** borders first to the 7 1/2" squares, then sew **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders to all blocks. ** (If panel measurements are slightly different, cut **F** borders slightly larger, sew borders around blocks then trim down to 12 1/2" x 12 1/2".)



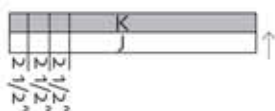

2. Make 18 - 12" finished (12 1/2" unf.) Chain Blocks. First, sew 9 pairs of **J/K** 2 1/2" strips, side by side. Subcut 144 - 2 1/2" segments. Sew segment together for 72 Four-Patches. Next, make 2 1/4 panels of strips **J/E/J**.

Subcut 18 - 4 1/2" segments for the middle row. Arrows indicate pressing directions.

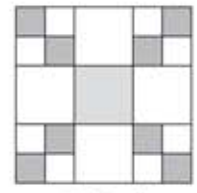
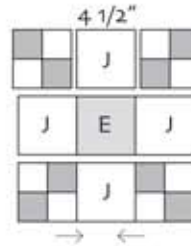

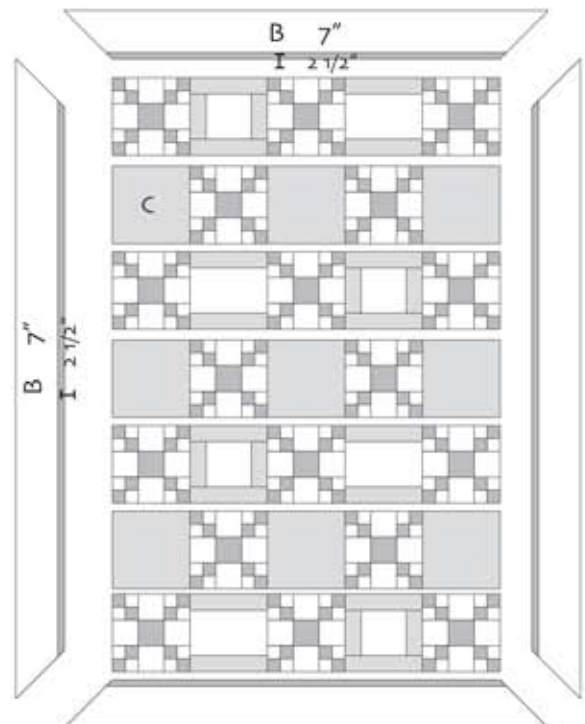

Next, sew Chain Blocks together by rows according to the diagram.

3. Sew Chain Blocks, Panel Blocks and C squares together by rows according to the diagram below.
4. Borders: Sew two **I** strips end to end for both **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders and two and one half strips end to end for both **SIDES** borders. Sew **I** borders to one side of **B** borders by matching centers. Next, sew borders to the quilt, **SIDES** first then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders by matching centers. Last, sew mitered angles.



5. Quilt measures approximately 76" x 100". Make backing (**G**) at least 6" larger than the top. Baste together top, batting and backing. Attach binding (**I**) and enjoy!!

Instructions for Window Boxes II Set of Four Placemats

1. Cut the following:

Fabric A - cut 4 - 9" x 14" by centering designs evenly

Fabric D - cut 4 - 15" x 20" (slightly larger BACKINGS)

Fabric H - cut 8 - 2 1/4" strips (2 strips will border one placemat)

Fabric L - cut 8 - 1 1/2" strips

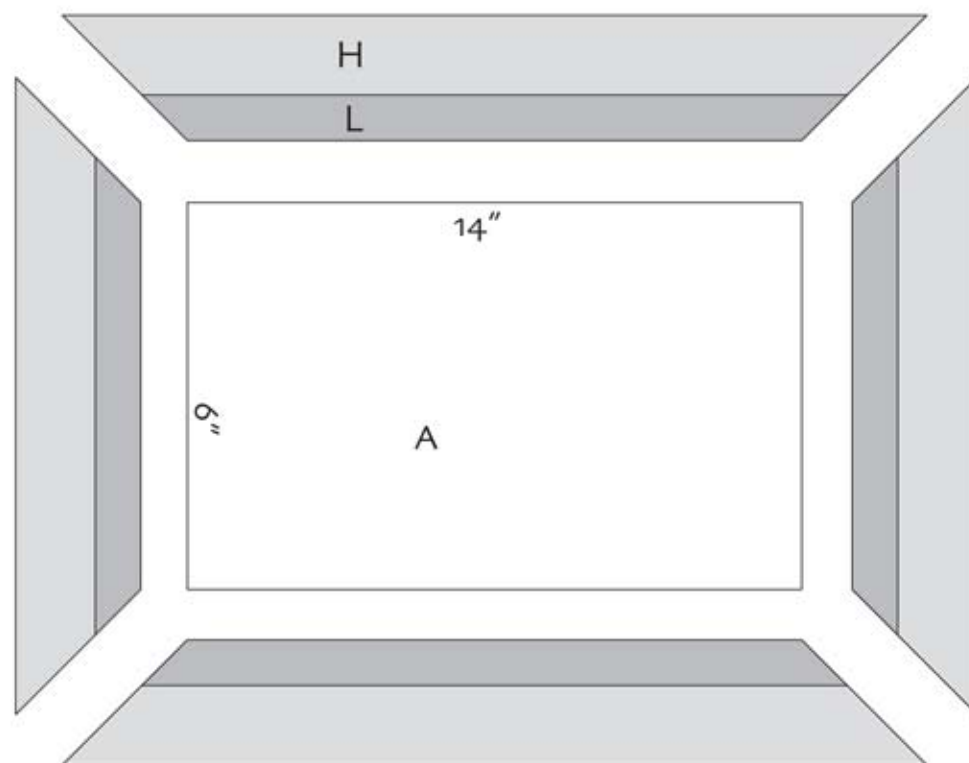
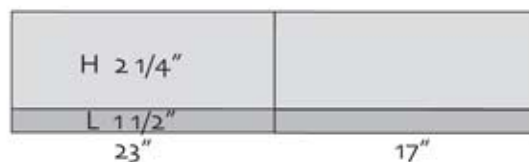
BINDING - cut 8 - 2 1/4" strips, sew end to end and press in half

Light BATTING - cut 4 - 15" x 20"

2. Piecing Order:

1. Sew **H** and **L** borders side by side, make 8 sets of border strips. Each border strip set will cover one **SIDE** and one **TOP** or **BOTTOM**, so 2 strip sets will cover one block. Cut each border strip set into 2 smaller borders - one approximately 17" long (**SIDES**) and one approximately 23" long (**TOP** or **BOTTOM**). These borders are slightly longer to allow for centering.

Sew borders around panel blocks (**A**), **SIDES FIRST** then **TOP** and **BOTTOM** borders by matching centers. Sew mitered angles last. Repeat for all 4 Placemats.



2. Layer **BACKING (D)**, **Light Batting** and **Placemats**. Quilt as desired. Attach **binding (L)** and enjoy!
