

Please read all instructions before starting. Measurements on borders are approximate, measure your quilt top before cutting

Yardage

Fabric A: 1915-409 Java	1/2 yard
Fabric B: 1915-533 Dark Olive	7/8 yard
Fabric C: 3400-100 Black	1/2 yard
Fabric D: 3400-108 Red	1/3 yard
Fabric E: 3400-119 Ivory	1/2 yard
Fabric F: 3400-208 Red	1/3 yard
Fabric G: 1915-523 Olive	1/6 yard
Fabric H: 3400-300 Black	1/4 yard
Backing: 3400-300 Black	1-1/2 yards

Cutting:

- Cut thirty 2-7/8" squares
 - Cut six 2-7/8" squares
 - Cut four 1" x 30-1/2"
 - Cut two 1" x 39-1/2"
 - Cut four 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding
 - Cut six 2-7/8" squares
 - Cut twelve 2-1/2" x 6-1/2"
 - Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" strips
 - Cut six 1-1/2" squares
 - Cut twelve 2-7/8" squares
 - Cut thirty 1-1/2" squares
 - Cut six 2-1/2" squares
 - Cut thirty-six 1-1/2" squares
 - Cut six 2-7/8" squares
 - Cut eight 4-1/2" squares
 - Cut one 38" x 48" piece for the backing
- Cut one 5" x width of fabric (WOF)
 - Cut six 2-1/2" squares
 - Cut two 1" x 21-1/2"
 - Cut six 1-1/2" squares
 - Cut one 5" x WOF strip
 - Cut one 5" x WOF strip
 - Cut twelve 2-1/2" squares
 - Cut one 5" x WOF strip
 - Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" strips

Aspen's Block Directions- make six 10-1/2" blocks total.

- 1) Place one 2-7/8" Fabric A square on top of one 2-7/8" fabric B square, right side together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two half-square triangles (Fig. 3).
- 2) Repeat Step One to make twelve Fabric A/B half-square triangles, twelve Fabric A/C half-square triangles, Twelve A/G half-squares triangles and twenty-four Fabric A/E half-square triangles.
- 3) Place one 1-1/2" Fabric F square on top of one A/E half-square triangle on the Fabric E corner (fig. 4) Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square. Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Repeat to make twelve A/E/F units.
- 4) Using the Flip and sew method as explained in Step 3, add one 1-1/2" Fabric E square to the upper right corner and lower left corner of one 2-1/2" Fabric F square. Repeat to make six E/F/E units.
- 5) Using the Flip and sew method as explained in Step 3, add one 1-1/2" Fabric F square to the lower left corner of one 2-1/2" Fabric F square. Repeat to make twelve F/E units.
- 6) Sew one 1-1/2" Fabric D square to the left side of one 1-1/2" Fabric C square. Press. Sew the D/C unit to the top of one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric D strip. Repeat to make six D/C units.
- 7) Sew one 1-1/2" Fabric E square to the left side of one 1-1/2" Fabric F square. Press. Sew the E/F unit to the top of one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric F strip. Repeat to make twelve E/F units.
- 8) Sew one 1-1/2" Fabric E square to the left side of one 1-1/2" Fabric D square. Press. Sew the E/F unit to the bottom of one 1-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric D strip. Repeat to make six D/E units.
- 9) Follow the block layout and sew together six blocks using all the units sewn above, six 2-1/2" Fabric A squares, six 2-1/2" Fabric B squares and twelve 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric C squares to make six 10-1/2" Blocks.
- 10) Sew three blocks to together to make one row. Repeat to make the second row. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
- 11) Sew one 1" x 30-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 1" x 21-1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 12) To make the pieced borders, cut an assortment of widths between 1" to 3" wide from the 5" x WOF Fabric A, C, D and E strips.
- 13) Refer to the quilt photo as a guide, sew the assorted strips together to make four 5" high x 9" wide strips and four 5" high x 14" wide strips. Trim them all to be 4-1/2" high to clean up the pieced edges.
- 14) To make the side borders, Sew one 4-1/2" x 9" pieced border to the top and bottom of one 4-1/2" Fabric H square for each side border. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
- 15) To make the top border, sew one 4-1/2" x 14" pieced strip to each side of one 4-1/2" Fabric H square. Sew one 4-1/2" Fabric H square to each end of the pieced sections. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew the borders to the quilt top.
- 16) Sew one 1" x 39-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Sew one 1" x 30-1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the quilt top.
- 17) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

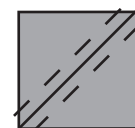

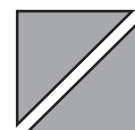

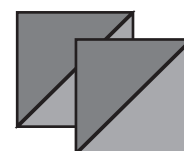

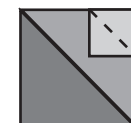
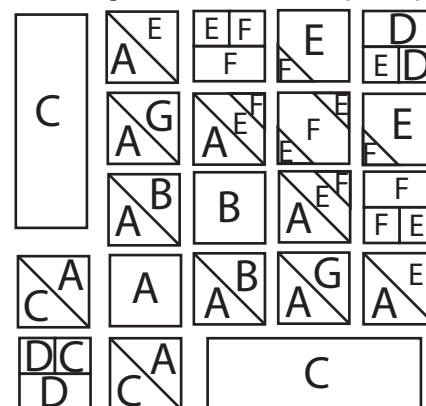

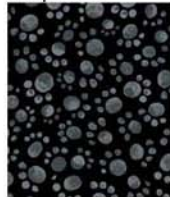
