Fabric C: 1-1/4 yds of 3504 Cocoa
Fabric D: 1-1/8 yds of 5474 Walnut
Fabric E: 1/4 yd of 5666 Honey
Fabric F: 1/3 yd of 5667 Hunter
Fabric G: 1-5/8 yds of 5796 Wedgewood
Fabric H: 1/3 yd of 5668 Sage
Fabric I: 1-3/4 yds of 5665 Wedgewood
Fabric J: 1/3 yd of 3504 Sun
Fabric K: 1/3 yd of 3504 Cardinal
Fabric L: Fat 1/16 of Plain White
Fabric M: Fat 1/16 of 3955 Jet
Backing: 6 yds of 5666 Honey

Fabric G: 1-5/8 yds of 5796 Olive
Fabric H: 1/3 yd of 5668 Ivory
Fabric I: 1-3/4 yds of 5665 Olive
Fabric J: 1/3 yd of 3504 Sun
Fabric K: 1/3 yd of 3504 Cardinal
Fabric L: Fat 1/16 of Plain White
Fabric M: Fat 1/16 of 3955 Jet
Backing: 6 yds of 5666 Chestnut

You Will Also Need: 2 yds of Fusible Web

Cutting Directions: (Note: WOF indicates cutting across the width of fabric)

Fabric A: Cut three 4-1/2" x 52-1/2" strips and one 8" x 52-1/2" strip from the length of fabric.
Cut six 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips, six 9-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips and eighteen 5-1/2" squares from the remaining fabric.

Fabric B: Cut eighteen 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips and eighteen 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.

Fabric C: Cut eighteen 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips, eighteen 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips and nine 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips.
See instructions to cut six tree trunks, two logs, and the sign letters.

Fabric D: Cut one 6" x 37" strip from the length of fabric for the sign. Cut eighteen 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips and eighteen 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" strips.

Fabric E: Cut nine 4-1/2" squares.

Fabric F: See instructions to cut six trees.

Fabric G: Cut sixteen 2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2" x 77" strips and eight 2" x 52-1/2" strips. Cut eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric H: Cut seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 1-1/2" x 77" strips and two 1-1/2" x 57-1/2" strips for the inner border.

Fabric I: Cut eight 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 6-1/2" x 79" strips and two 6-1/2" x 69-1/2" strips for the Outer Border.

Fabric J: See instructions to cut two large fires, seven fish and eight fines.

Fabric K: See instructions to cut two small fires, eight fish and seven fines.

Fabric L: See instructions to cut fifteen outer eyes

Fabric M: See instructions to cut fifteen inner eyes.

Backing: Cut two 98" x WOF strips and piece them together to make one 78" x 98" piece for the backing.

Assembly Instructions, diagrams and templates on following pages.

Assembly Instructions:

1. To make the house block center, sew one 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of one 4-1/2" Fabric E square. Sew one 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the 4-1/2" Fabric E square.
2. Sew one 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the block center. Sew one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of the block center.
3. Sew one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the block center. Sew one 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the block center to complete the bottom of the house block.
4. To make the roof, Place one 5-1/2" Fabric A square on the left side of one 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.
5. Place another 5-1/2" Fabric A square on the right side of the 5-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.


6. Sew one roof to the top of the house bottom block from Step 3.
7. Repeat Steps 1-6 to make nine 10-1/2" x 15-1/2" house blocks.
8. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web.
9. Cut out each fusible template outside the drawn lines about 1/8".
10. Press each shape to the back side of the fabrics as listed in the cutting directions.
11. To make the sign, press fusible web onto the back side 6" x 37" Fabric D strip. Trim the strip to measure 5" x 36".
12. Refer to the quilt photo and free form cut each end of the sign as shown.
13. Evenly space the letters onto the sign and press in place. Press the sign to the center of one 8" x 52-1/2" Fabric A strip.
14. Refer to the quilt photo and press the two logs, two large fires and two small fires to the 8" x 52-1/2" Fabric A strip as shown.
15. Press one tree and one trunk to the center of each 9-1/2" x 15-1/2" Fabric A piece to make six tree blocks.
16. Refer to the quilt photo of color placement and press five fish with fins and eyes to each 4-1/2" x 52-1/2" background strip evenly spacing the fish. Make three fish rows.
17. Using a decorative stitch such as a satin or buttonhole stitch and stitch around each appliqueed shape.

Assembling the Quilt Top:


18. Starting with one House block, sew together three house blocks and two tree blocks, alternating them to make one house row. Sew one 2-1/2" x 15-1/2" Fabric A strip to each end of the house row. Repeat to make three house rows.
19. Refer to the quilt photo to sew the three house rows, three fish rows, one sign row and eight 2" x 52-1/2" Fabric G strips together to make the quilt top.
20. Sew one 2" x 77" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top.
21. Sew one 1-1/2" x 77" Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 57-1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
22. Sew one 6-1/2" x 79" Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 6-1/2" x 69-1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
23. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.




Inner Eye

Trace five reversed




