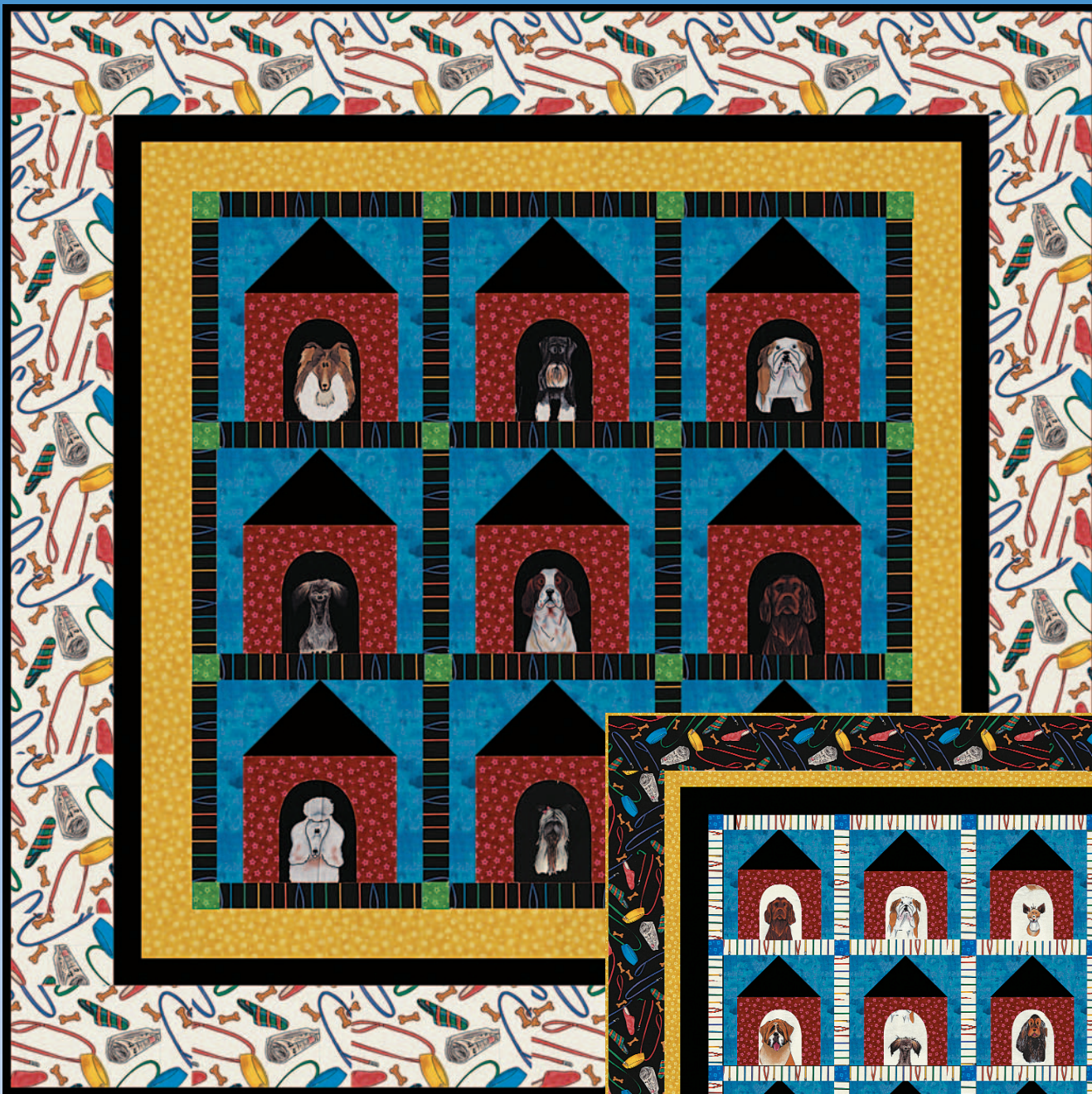

All seam allowances are 1/4". Please read all directions before beginning and press carefully after each step.

Fabric Requirements:

Ivory Version

Fabric A: 1/2 yd M4875 Sea
Fabric B: 1/2 yd of 4387 Red Pepper
Fabric C: 1/4 yd of 3955 Jet
Fabric D: 1/2 yd of 5242 Black
Fabric E: 1/3 yd of 5243 Black
Fabric F: 1/8 yd of 4387 Artichoke
Fabric G: 1/3 yd of 4387 Lemonade
Fabric H: 5/8 yd of 3955 Jet
Fabric I: 3/4 yd of 5244 Ivory
Backing: 2 yds of 5243 Black
Fusible Web: 1 yd

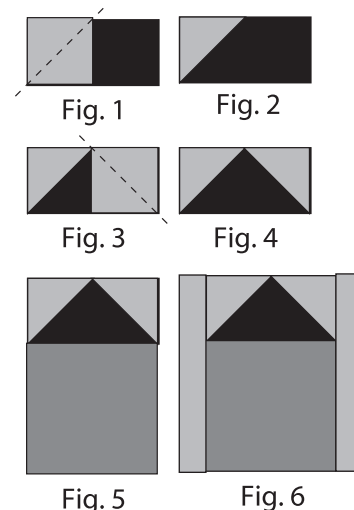
Fabric A: 1/2 yd M4875 Sea
Fabric B: 1/2 yd of 4387 Red Pepper
Fabric C: 1/4 yd of 3955 Jet
Fabric D: 1/2 yd of 5242 Ivory
Fabric E: 1/3 yd of 5243 Ivory
Fabric F: 1/8 yd of 4388 Jelly
Fabric G: 1/3 yd of 3955 Jet
Fabric H: 5/8 yd of 4387 Lemonade
Fabric I: 3/4 yd of 5244 Black
Backing: 2 yds of 5243 Ivory
Fusible Web: 1 yd

Cutting Directions:

Fabric A: Cut eighteen 3-1/2" squares and eighteen 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
Fabric B: Cut nine 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" pieces.
Fabric C: Cut nine 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.
Fabric D: See instructions to fussy cut nine dogs.
Fabric E: Cut twenty-four 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips.
Fabric F: Cut sixteen 1-1/2" squares.
Fabric G: Cut two 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips and two 2-1/2" x 28-1/2" strips for Border One.
Fabric H: Cut two 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips and two 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" strips for Border Two.
Cut five 2-1/4" x width of fabric strips for Binding.
Fabric I: Cut two 4-1/2" x 42-1/2" strips and two 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" strips for Border Three.
Backing: Sew into one 48" square for the backing.

Assembly Instructions:

1. Place one 3-1/2" Fabric A square on the left side of one 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Mark and sew across the diagonal from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Open out the triangle formed and finger press the seam open (Fig. 2). Check that the corners are aligned squarely. Flip the triangle back down and trim away the excess fabric approximately 1/4" for the seam allowance.
2. Place another 3-1/2" Fabric A square on the right side of the 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Mark and sew across the diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4) to make one Doghouse Roof.
3. Repeat Steps 1 & 2 to make nine Doghouse Roof pieces total.
4. Sew each Doghouse Roof to the top of each 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B square to make the doghouses (Fig. 5).
5. Sew one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A strip to each side of the doghouses to make nine 8-1/2" doghouse blocks (Fig. 6).
6. Following the manufacturer's instructions and trace nine templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about a 1/4" outside of the drawn lines.
7. Position each fusible web template over a different dog on Fabric D on the back side of the fabric. Once the template is centered over a dog, press it in place. Cut out each template on the drawn line.
8. Center one dog onto each Doghouse block and press in place. Finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
9. Starting and ending with one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E strip, sew together four 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E strips and three doghouse blocks, alternating them to make one Block Row. Repeat to make three Block Rows.
10. Starting and ending with a 1-1/2" Fabric F square, sew together four 1-1/2" Fabric F squares and three 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric E strips, alternating them to make one Sashing Row. Repeat to make four Sashing Rows.
11. Starting and ending with one Sashing Row, sew together the four Sashing Rows and three Block Rows to make the quilt top.
12. Sew one 2-1/2" x 28-1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
13. Sew one 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
14. Sew one 4-1/2" x 34-1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4-1/2" x 42-1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
15. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
