All seam allowances are 1/4". Please read all directions before beginning and press carefully after each step.

Fabric Requirements:

Cutting Directions:

- Fabric A:** 1/3 yd 5499 Camel (1) 8-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (4) 8-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once for (8) triangles.
- Fabric B:** 1-1/2 yd 5499 Ivory (1) 8-1/2" x wof strip, recut into (4) 8-1/2" squares
 (1) 8-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (2) 8-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once for (4) triangles, trim remainder to 6-1/8" and cut (1) 6-1/8" square for center star block.
 (4) 6-1/8" x wof strips, recut into (24) 6-1/8" squares for borders.
- Fabric C:** 2/3 yd 5499 Olive (2) 8-7/8" x wof strip; recut into (8) 8-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once for (16) triangles.
- Fabric D:** 1/4 yd 5501 Olive (1) 4-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (4) 4-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once for (8) triangles.
- Fabric E:** 1/3 yd 5501 Red (1) 8-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (4) 8-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once for (8) triangles.
- Fabric F:** 1/3 yd 5503 Camel (1) 9-1/4" x wof strip, recut into (4) 9-1/4" squares, then cut in half on diagonal twice to make a total of (16) triangles. From remainder of strip cut (1) 5-1/4" square and cut in half on diagonal twice for (4) triangles.
- Fabric G:** 1/3 yd 5503 Olive (1) 8-7/8" x wof strip, recut (2) 8-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make a total of (4) triangles.
- Fabric H:** 1/3 yd 5503 Red (1) 8-7/8" x wof strip, recut (2) 8-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make a total of (4) triangles.
- Fabric I:** 1-1/4 yd 5504 Ivory (2) 9-1/4" x wof strips, recut into (5) 9-1/4" squares, then cut in half on diagonal twice to make a total of (20) triangles. From remainder of 2nd strip cut (2) 8-7/8" squares and cut in half on diagonal once for (4) border triangles. Trim strip again to 4-7/8" and recut (2) squares to be cut in half on diagonal once for (4) small triangles for star block. (6) 2-1/2" x wof strips, sew together end-to-end then cut (2) vertical borders 48-1/2" long and (2) horizontal borders 52-1/2" long. From remainder cut (4) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" pieces.
- Fabric J:** 2/3 yd 5504 Moss (2) 9-1/4" x wof strips, recut into (5) 9-1/4" squares, then cut in half on diagonal twice to make a total of (20) triangles. From remainder of strip cut (4) 4-7/8" squares and cut in half on diagonal.
- Fabric K:** 2/3 yd 5504 Red (2) 9-1/4" x wof strips, recut into (5) 9-1/4" squares, then cut in half on diagonal twice to make a total of (20) triangles. From remainder of strip cut (4) 4-7/8" squares and cut in half on diagonal once for (8) triangles.
- Fabric L:** 1/4 yd 5505 Red (1) 4-7/8" x wof strip, recut into (2) 4-7/8" squares, then cut in half on diagonal once to make a total of (4) triangles.
- Backing:** 4 yd fabric 5505 Red Cut backing fabric in half for (2) 2 yd pieces, sew together along selvedge edge then trim to 72" x 72" for backing.
- Binding:** 1/2 yd fabric 5501 Olive Cut (7) 2-1/4" x wof strips and sew together end-to-end.

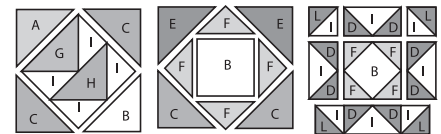

Sewing:

1. Sew the 9 blocks for the center of the quilt, following the placement of the fabrics in the quilt diagram. There is 1 center star block, 4 square blocks and 4 flying geese blocks. (Diagram 1)
2. Arrange the blocks as shown in the quilt diagram and sew them together in 3 rows of 3 blocks each. (Diagram 2)
3. Sew a vertical fabric I border to opposite sides of the quilt center and the horizontal borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
4. Referring to the border diagram, sew the square in square border strip together. Make 4 rows. Sew two rows to opposite sides of the quilt top. (Diagram 3)
5. Sew a fabric I 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" piece to each end of the two remaining square in square borders. Sew cornerstone triangles together and join to the ends to the horizontal borders. Sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

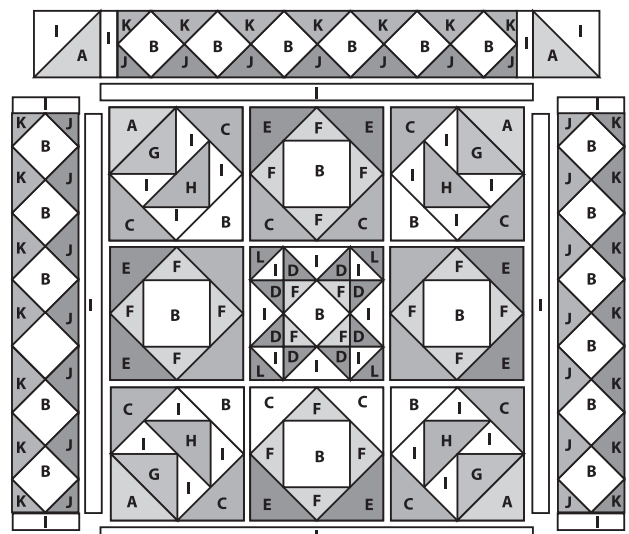

Finishing:

6. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing. Baste, then quilt the layers together.
7. Fold the binding strips over lengthwise and press, then sew to quilt top raw edges together. Turn binding to back of quilt and stitch in place.
